

Offenders placed in this caseload are sentenced to community supervision for an alcohol related offense and ordered by the sentencing court to install an automobile ignition interlock device for half of their term of community supervision or a home monitoring device for the full term of community supervision. The devices are intended to monitor the offender's alcohol use. The automobile ignition device requires that the offender blow into the device before starting their vehicle. The home monitor also requires that the offender blow into the device to monitor alcohol consumption by the offender. The community supervision officer assigned this caseload monitors the offender violation reports and initiates progressive sanctions as deemed necessary.
