

The Treatment Alternatives to Incarceration Program is designed to provide intensive treatment services to offenders who have a substance abuse addiction problem. Referrals can be made as an initial court ordered condition of supervision or as an alternative sanction to revocation of community supervision. Eligibility criteria is established when the offender has a history of substance abuse, at least two positive drug tests or a substance abuse evaluation which determines that the offender qualifies for services. The services provided by the Program are contracted with Concilio Hispano Libre, a local vendor which is overseen by the Association for the Advancement of Mexican Americans (AAMA), which provides outpatient group and individual counseling services. The term of this program is usually six months.
