ADDENDUM TO SECOND EMERGENCY ORDER REGARDING THE
COVID-19
STATE OF DISASTER

To all attorneys and parties with pending cases at the State District Courts of Webb County:

The following Addendum will be in place until June 30, 2020.

1. The Second Emergency Order Regarding COVID-19 directed by the Webb County District Courts continues to be in effect.
2. All jury trials for June will be postponed for dates COORDINATED WITH EACH individual court. July jury trials and those scheduled afterwards shall remain unchanged.
3. Parties and attorneys with pending jury trials should refer to the upcoming changes in the Webb County Jury Plan, which will be made as the State District Judges of Webb County continue to monitor the COVID-19 pandemic.
4. In addition, an operating plan for in-person court hearings will be implemented by June 1, 2020.
