MOTION FOR DEFERRED ADJUDICATION OF GUILT

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

COMES NOW the Defendant, _____, in the above styled and numbered cause and moves the Court to defer further proceedings without entering an adjudication of guilt and place the defendant on community supervision and in support thereof would show the Court as follows:

I.

That the Defendant herein was indicted for the felony offense of Possession of Controlled Substance, a State Jail Felony, alleged to have been committed on or about _____ day of _____, 20____.

II.

That Article 42A. 101 provides as follows:

“Except as provided by Article 42A. 102(b), if in the judge's opinion the best interest of society and the defendant will be served, the Judge may, after receiving a plea of guilty or plea of nolo contendere, hearing the evidence, and finding that it substantiates the defendant's guilt, defer further proceedings without entering an adjudication of guilt, and place the defendant on deferred adjudication community supervision.”

III.

That the Defendant has entered a plea of guilty to Possession of Controlled Substance, a State Jail Felony, before the Court, as the Defendant fully admits all culpability involved in this crime. The Defendant would further submit that, in mitigation of punishment, the following facts are relevant:

1. That the Defendant has never been convicted of a felony in this or any other state or of any federal court.

- The Defendant has no prior psychiatric history and has no mental deficiency or defect.

IV.

The Defendant respectfully submits that in view of the Defendant's plea of guilty and the particular facts and circumstances involved in this case, that the interest of justice would be served if this Honorable Court, after hearing evidence, finds that the evidence substantiates the Defendant's guilt, but defers further proceedings without entering an adjudication of guilt and places the Defendant on community supervision for an appropriate period of time.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Defendant respectfully prays that this Honorable Court will defer further proceedings without entering an adjudication of guilt and place the Defendant on community supervision herein.
