The number of trucks that are currently use is 3 refuse trucks

3- Type of equipment used.

Side loader 25 yards auto reach with proportional controls.

4- Number and size of current containers.

2,250 containers / 96 gal.

3 employees and 1 Supervisor.

6- Number of current customers.

Non ETJ 930 containers and ETJ 1,287 containers.

7- Frequency of current services.

Once a week.

11- Do all locations have an address?

Webb County has implemented 9-1-1 or physical addressing throughout the unincorporated areas of the county; however, not all residents are familiar or remember their physical addresses since most areas do not possess mail service. Known physical addresses can be provided by either the county or the customer. Otherwise, as part of a service contract, the customer can be required to furnish the successful bidder with a E9-1-1 address form issued by the Webb County Planning Department.

12- Is this an exclusive contract for service?

Webb County prefers to negotiate an exclusive contract for service for the entirety of the unincorporated area of the county but will entertain proposals for specific territories if such proposals will be more beneficial to the public/customers.
